EASTCONN Moving To New Willimantic Location

WESTBROOK, CT—This fall the educational non-profit EASTCONN will be moving its Willimantic facility from Windham Mills to 1320 Main Street. This was announced by Ron Lyman, CCIM, CEO of Lyman Real Estate, which owns the new location. Lyman said the lease will begin November 1 after work on refitting the space for the new tenant is completed this summer.

EASTCONN was created in 1980 by Connecticut law as a public non-profit regional educational service center. It serves 36 boards of education in 33 communities through seven locations in northeastern Connecticut. Willimantic is the site of the EASTCONN Community Learning Center, which provides adult education, community services and a driving school.
